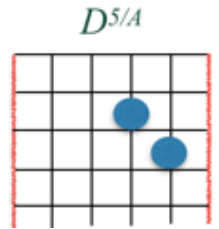


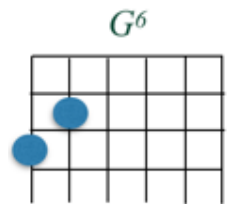
All Hail the Power of Jesus Name

Scripture and History

Philippians 2:6-11 Have among yourselves the same attitude that is also yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross.

Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.



"**All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name**" is often called the "National Anthem of Christendom. The lyrics, written by Edward Perronet while he served as a missionary in India, first appeared in the November, 1779 issue of the *Gospel Magazine*, which was edited by the renowned author of "Rock of Ages" Augustus Toplady. The text has been translated into almost every (if not every) language in which Christianity is known. The best-known tunes used for the hymn are "Coronation" and "Miles Lane", with "Diadem" the favored one in Australia, but there are a number of others. "Diadem" is also the most favored tune sung as a choir number.
