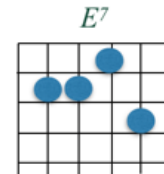

who is to shepherd my people Israel.’”

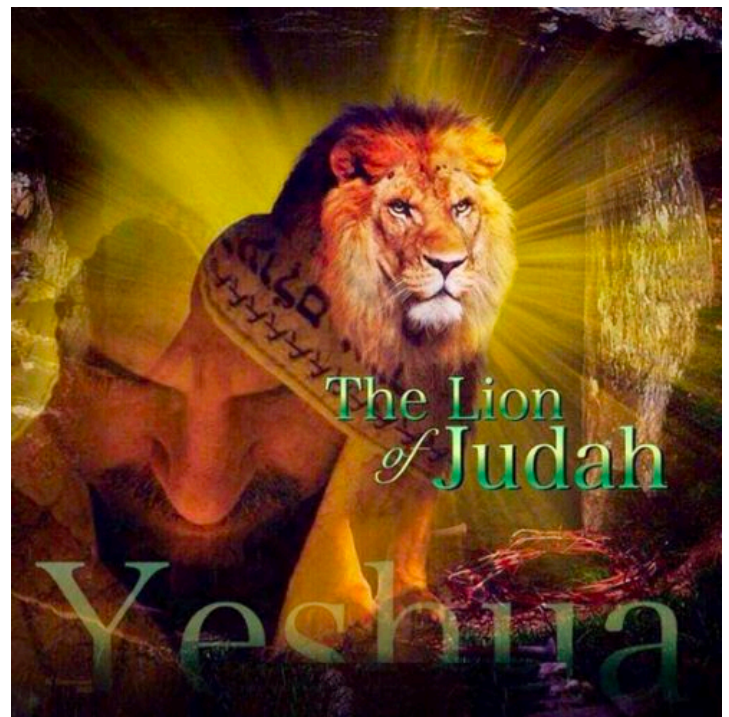
